The panel will seek individuals who demonstrate a commitment to their companies, their employees and their community. The award particularly recognizes accomplishments of the previous year. All decisions of the judges are final.

Complete the attached nomination form and submit to *BC Homes Magazine* with the following information.

1. C.V. of nominee. Include a list of any personal or corporate awards received.
2. 500-word description of the nominee's achievements and compelling reasons why you feel he/she deserves to be considered for BC's Residential Construction Person of the Year. Include details of the nominee's impact upon his/her company, industry and community.
3. Letters of reference from colleagues and friends (no more than five).
4. Description of the corporation for whom the nominee works, including detail on the company's corporate culture, financial performance, human resources practices, customer service policies and continuous improvement programs.
5. Any additional news clippings or ancillary information that will support the nomination.
